The appellation owes its name to a Roman legionary and not to any old bouquet of flowers.

This municipal naming of 800 hectares produces, on an exclusively granitic basement, velvet wines.

Rich and fine, their elegance and their charm often make consider this wine as the most feminine among all the Beaujolais vineyards.

THE PRODUCER

Frederic Montangeron took back the family 14Ha wide estate in 1996 among whom 10 Ha in Fleurie Appellation.

The soil of "La Madone" of pure pink granite allows the expression of flowers and mineral character of this vineyard. A wine of feminine and distinguished velvet, a pure pleasure.

ESTATE PRODUCTION

- Grape variety : Gamay
- Age of the vineyards: 60 years
- Surface : 10 Ha
- Situation : East - hillsides
- Soil : Granitic and sandy

VINIFICATION

- Manuel grape-picking
- Whole grapes are gathered in vats – no crushing – no destemming
- controlled temperature
- Maceration : 9 days

WINE MATURING

- Concrete and stainless still vats.
- Filtration
- Bottling in spring

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE WINE

Colour : dark carmin red colour

Nose : fruity and floral aromas : iris, black current violet, and faded rose

Tasting : elegance, finesse and a fleshy and silky body *Dominante* : charming and round
