TASTING NOTES

Cold vinification to preserve the aromas of the grape and avoid oxidation problems allows us to obtain a fresh, limpid and very aromatic wine. A nose of green apples, boxwood and citrus fruits, a pale yellow color with green reflections, a frank attack dominated by citrus scents with a hint of vegetal finish. Type: fresh and fruity white wine

HISTORY

Located in the South of France, between the historic city of Nîmes and the Mediterranean Sea, Château Saint-Bénezet is located in the town of Saint-Gilles, at the southern end of the Rhône Valley.

Since 1999, the estate has been managed by Yann Soulairac and Elise Bosse-Platière. It extends over more than 200 ha entirely cultivated in "Terra Vitis" sustainable agriculture.
