VINIFICATION

- Mechanical harvesting
- Crushing
- Filling in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks
- Alcoholic fermentation under marc
- Malolactic fermentation
- Filtration with tangential filter
- Ageing in vats for 14 to 18 months
- Bottling with our own material
